## August!...

I asked the CHP a question.....

Sir:

I would like to know if a child over 60#s can ride in an antique car (a car that had no seat belts from the factory) that is not equipped with seatbelts?

Thank you for writing to the CHP. California law states: Children **MUST** be properly secured in an appropriate child passenger restraint system until they are at least 6 years old OR weigh at least 60 pounds. However, best practice is always to keep your child in a child safety seat until the vehicle's seat belt system fits them properly.

Safety belts are not required in vehicles manufactured before the federal government mandated them. Even with California's present safety belt law, if you are in one of these vehicles, you are not required to use a safety belt (although you can retrofit them and be a lot safer).

**HOWEVER, if you transport a child, which because of age or weight, must ride in a child safety seat or booster seat under California law, then you MUST use a "properly attached" safety seat in that vehicle. And, of course, the only proper attachment is a safety belt!**
